Make It Happen by Coach Kris Thaller

How to spring back into shape... At times like these you want to be cognitively agile. You see which thoughts or actions are no longer appropriate and you are willing to practice courage and resilience regardless of the chaos that surrounds you. Resiliency is the capacity to recover quickly from difficulties and spring back into shape.

Next, you will need to practice surrendering to the current situation. Surrender does not mean giving up. Surrender is not an action rather, it's insight. Insight is simply discernment and discernment is the capacity to see clearly what is before you so that your next action is obvious, authentic and productive.

Until you develop the capacity to discern, your actions are often aimless and waste your energy. Remember, you have whatever it takes to meet the challenges that exist on your Life's Journey.

Willa Cather said it like this: "Miracles rest not so much upon healing power coming suddenly near us from afar, but upon our perceptions being made finer, so that, for the moment, our eyes can see and our ears can hear what has been there around us always." World Peace Meditation

Today we will try an experiment in visualization – with a slight twist: our eyes will be open. It is the illusion of separation that enables us to hold judgments about people, places, and things – the belief that there is "me" and there is "other than me." In order to truly experience peace, not only in our own hearts, but in our world and our universe, we MUST dispel that illusion. So, just for today, whatever you look at and especially whatever you touch, I invite you to squint, just a little bit, so that your focus diffuses. Then you can visualize the very atoms of your body and that which you have encountered mingling together.

Imagine that you see only the one Life of God that animates all living things – and remember that everything IS a living thing. Imagine you can feel the pulse of the person you look at, see and feel the warmth of the sun on the tree branch, experience the heartbeat of the red bird – it is, we are, you are ONE.

If this resonates with you take 15-20 minutes to sit with the idea, try it on for size, and then go out and see what happens when you see, as God sees, a whole new world around and within you.

The Number 40

If you are a Unity metaphysics student, you know that forty is a highly significant number. It stands for "as long as it takes." Currently we are experiencing "shelter in place" instructions and we hear the word quarantine a lot.

The word quarantine comes from a French word derived from Latin first used in 1617 when a ship was held in port for 40 days to assure the sailors did not spread disease. The original Latin word is "quadraginta" or forty. Forty days is the time frame used in history to protect populations from the spread of disease. It was the only defense they had. Today, due to modern science and medicine, fourteen days quarantine are recommended for isolation to stop the spread of illness. Fourteen is also from the same Latin root.

Other evidence supporting the metaphysics of the number forty are various Biblical stories: the flood lasted forty days; the people of Israel spent forty years in the wilderness; Moses spent forty days on Mount Sinai receiving the Commandments; Jesus fasted forty days.

Many theologians consider the number forty to represent change, or the time required to clear away the old way of thinking and make way for new thought and new consciousness. For example, the people of Israel could not enter their new paradigm until those who had been slaves and had slave-consciousness had passed away.

We are in the year 2020. It is no coincidence that 20 + 20 = 40. The change of consciousness on this planet is in motion and it will require as long as it takes. A new paradigm will emerge. It is significant that we recognize that 2020 represents perfect vision. I invite you to recall that our theme for this year is **2020 Vision in 2020**! And, the theme for the Unity Movement is: **Perfect Vision: Seeing Through a Spiritual Lens**. This is a time for us to envision the highest and the best that we can conceive of.

Let us hold all these observations lightly as we move through this time of quarantine. Let us find the good in this experience: see our rivers refreshing, the air becoming cleaner, the earth balancing and harmonizing in a time of rest, new solutions coming forth for many problems and a new value system emerging. Let us claim health and healing for all life upon the planet and for the planet itself. Practice your Truth to claim the Good for yourself, your dear ones, and all people. It will take as long as it takes and we will evolve to a higher awareness of our divinity. Know yourself to be safe and divinely guided through every challenge.
