Friendship Home is somewhat unique in that family units are kept together. Unlike many social service organizations, teenage boys are kept within the family wherever possible and healthy for everyone... Usually the family unit is the mother and children. Now however, they are also serving families that do not fit the old paradigm. They are providing shelter, counseling and support services for abused LBGTO persons and others.

When Unity Lincoln is back in its building, we look forward to joining with Friendship Home presenters as their expert personnel share some of their programs with us.
